Eligibility of Voting Age:

This question is answered as Item 13 in the MCTC AGM Minutes of: March 28, 2026.

13. *Unscheduled discussion* occurred regarding Juniors Members have voting rights at any MCTC events;

The MCTC Secretary advised:

13.1: That the MCTC Constitution (Rules) and,

13.2: The ACTA Constitution are both mute on the age of members to vote on members matters.

13.3: The Associations Incorporation Reform Act 2012 is also mute on the same matter.

13.4: The MCTC Consumer Affairs Victoria Officer also couldn't assist with direction as the Act is mute.

CAV Case Number: 2026 – 03 – 012028 (Now Closed).

13.5: Advice by CAV was to seek a legal opinion. Legal advice was undertaken, that in this case, normal Community Norms should apply:

- *Voting at State Elections*
- *Voting at Federal Elections*
- *Purchasing and consumption of alcohol*
- *Unrestricted - Motor Vehicle Licences*

are restricted to eighteen (18) years old, therefore MCTC should recognise this community standard of eighteen (18) years.
